We also collect information to better understand how visitors use this website and to present timely, relevant information to them.

What data we gather

We will collect and process the following data about you:

- App information we collect about you. P.Logic games incorporate analytics feedback (e.g. player level progress) so that we can improve the app experience. No personal data is collected.
- Public app leaderboard information we collect about you. P.Logic games incorporate app leaderboards by use of GameCenter integration for iOS devices. The leaderboard displays your username and score only.
- Website information we collect about you. This website is built using Wix
 (www.wix.com). Wix will automatically collect the following information: technical
 information, including the Internet protocol (IP) address used to connect your
 computer to the Internet, your login information, browser type and version, browser
 plug-in types and versions and operating system and platform.
- Website information about your visit. This website is built using Wix (www.wix.com). Wix will automatically collect the following information: the full

Uniform Resource Locators (URL), clickstream to, through and from the website (including date and time), page response times, download errors, length of visits to certain pages, page interaction information (such as scrolling, clicks, and mouse-overs), methods used to browse away from the page.

Cookies and how we use them

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small file placed on your computer's hard drive. It enables our website to identify your computer as you view different pages on our website.

Cookies allow websites and applications to store your preferences in order to present content, options or functions that are specific to you. They also enable us to see information like how many people use the website and what pages they tend to visit.

How are you is cookies

We may use cookies to:

- Analyse our web traffic using an analytics package. Aggregated usage data helps us improve the website structure, design, content and functions.
